START SMALL: Work your way up. Build your skills.

Your Responsibility Code

1. Always stay in control, and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
2. People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
3. You must not stop where you obstruct a trail, or are not visible from above.
4. Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
5. Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
6. Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
7. Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely.

It's Your Responsibility To Know How To Use & Ride The Lift Safely

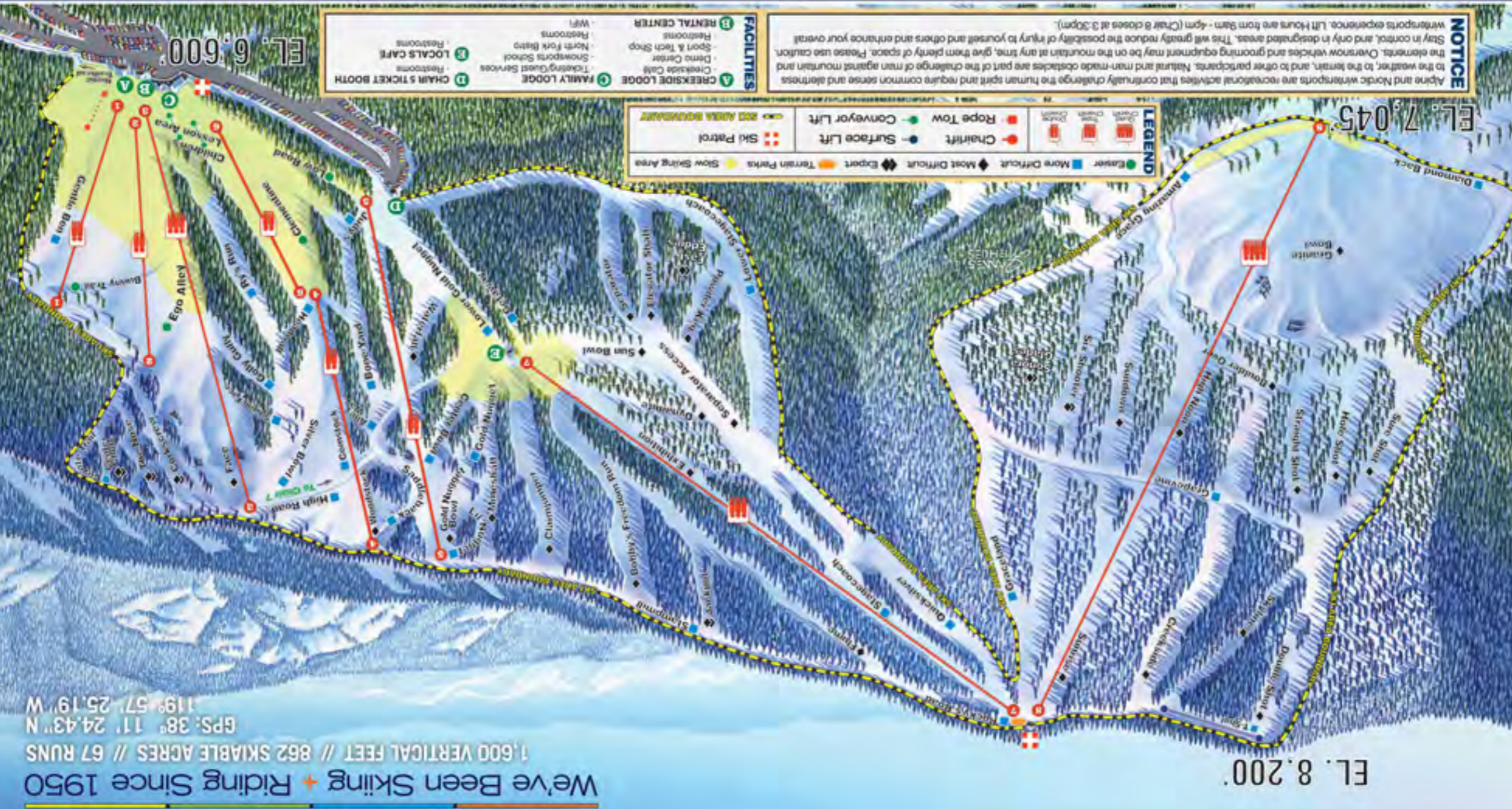
GET ON // SIT BACK, SIT STILL, HOLD ON // AT THE TOP, PLAN AHEAD TO UNLOAD

- Need assistance? Ask the lift attendant for help.
- Smallest kids should load closest to the attendant.
- Remove & carry packs.
- It is OK to miss a chair and wait for the next one.
- When loading, watch for the approaching chair and then sit to the back once seated!
- Do not use phones, music or games while loading or unloading.
- Drop something? Let it FALL.
- Any item dropped can be picked up later.
- Absolutely NO horseplay on the lifts!
